Dotted Quarter Note -

Remember: a dot after a note increases its duration by half the original value.

In $\overset{?}{4}$, $\overset{?}{4}$ and $\overset{?}{4}$, a quarter note receives one beat. Because a dot following a quarter note increases its duration by ½ beat, a dotted quarter note has a value of 1½ beats.
